A document that I put together from the pdf of the Slade Kelson diaries available from Memorial University's digital archives. The pdf was over 1800 pages and not in date order, so I excerpted the Coleman references and put them in date order. – Lara McKnight

Saturday 6th May 1826

Sunday 20th May 1827

Thursday 21st Octr 1830

...Court was opened again this day and little business was transacted_ between Wm Spencer Senr and two of Coleman-s sons, the two latter, stood charged by the former, for havig stabb-d his mare some time ago with a pew which caused her death_ the affair was settled by arbitration, and Spencer was partly identified_ by the arbitrators adjudging & awarding a fine against the two Colemans in the sum of 40 - each_ The Court was finally closed, and the Judge anticipates leaving this for Harbor Grace tomorrow,

Wednesday 12th Sept 1832

...Spence-s Schr Three Sisters arriv-d with fish from the Labrador Coast_Pat Doughertys, J & P Moores-s & B. Coleman-s Skiff_ came in last night from Bverds fishing ground with a good trip of fish each

Monday 30th Sept 1833

...The causes that came on to be heard in Court this day were -Langhman- v. -Coleman- about a fishing Room in Green Island Cove, which is to be settled by arbitration_ and the -Relief Committee- Stevenson for the recovery of - 4.7.6_ amot of his proportion of guarantee_ The Court award cost & charges of writ against Stevenson in favor of the - Committee

...The affair at Court -Langhman v Coleman was settled in fav of Langhman_ Coleman being obligated to (?) the (?) & pay (?)

Thursday 9th Jany 1834

...Mr. John Skelton overland from Bonavista Tuesday evening and yesterday amputated Peter Coleman-s hand at the wrist, so that he is now in a fair way of recovery
